Join the 2021 Truck Convoy

The Truck Convoy for Special Olympics Nebraska is back for 2021 but with a different format. The Truck Convoy festivities will ALL take place in Grand Island this year at Bosselman Travel Center, 3335 W. Wood River Rd September 17 & 18. Due to COVID concerns the Truck Convoy will not travel this year, all trucks will come into Grand Island on the 17th or the morning of the 18th and remain parked at Bosselman's. Special Olympics athletes, drivers and law enforcement will take part in games, auctions and cookouts, just like in year's past, but the Truck Convoy will not actually convoy.

To be part of the Truck Convoy truckers or trucking companies much register and pay a \$100 entry fee per truck. All funds raised from the event will benefit the athletes and programs of Special Olympics Nebraska. Registration forms can be turned in at the event or sent to the Special Olympics Nebraska office. Each registrant will receive a Truck Convoy goody bag and are encouraged to take part in all the activities associated with the Truck Convoy. Participants will be welcomed by Special Olympics athletes and their families, colleagues, law enforcement and the organizations that make up the trucking industry.

The Truck Convoy is part of the Law Enforcement Torch Run for Special Olympics Nebraska and is a great way for truckers and law enforcement to work together in the community and send a positive message about the work they do.

TYPES OF VEHICLES REQUIRED

Semi-trucks, truck/trailer combinations, large trucks, low-boys, dump trucks, flat beds, buses, large tow trucks, large box trucks, etc. All trucks entering the Truck Convoy must be of 10-GVW or larger.

Please note: No Hazardous Materials or Trucks with Alcohol or Tobacco Names or Logos are Permitted.

TORCH RUN

The Law Enforcement Torch Run (LETR) for Special Olympics Nebraska is the largest public awareness vehicle and grass-roots fundraiser for Special Olympics. The mission of the LETR is to increase awareness and raise funds for local Special Olympics athletes. The Nebraska LETR decided this year to combine two of their signature events, the Truck Convoy and Torch Run Week, to gain even more awareness for Nebraska athletes and hopefully increase donations. The Torch Run consists of local law enforcement, athletes and supporters running the Special Olympics torch within their communities to raise awareness for Special Olympics. On Saturday, September 18th there will be a Torch Run entering the Opening Ceremonies of the Truck Convoy. Law enforcement, athletes, drivers and community members are all encouraged to take part in the run around Bosselman's. The Torch Run will start at 9am and end around 9:30am. Registration for the Run will be available at sone.org or at the Truck Convoy.
