<b>TOURNEY FORMAT: TRADITIONAL</b>	-Traditional Team, Traditional Doubles, and Singles -Total score of 3 games bowled. -Teams will bowl against other teams in their division. -If a member of the team doesn't show up, they receive a zero.
<b>RULES:</b>	Special Olympics official bowling rules, with SONE amendments
<b>ELIGIBILITY:</b>	-All bowlers, must be currently registered with SONE/SOI, with current medical form on file, and release/consent. -Day of competition SONE/SOI registration will not be permitted.
<b>EVENT LIMITS:</b>	This is a state event, so it is a qualifier for higher competition.
<b>ENTRY PROCEDURE:</b>	Entries will be advanced from Regional Competitions.
<b>SCRATCH DEADLINE AND LATE ENTRY DEADLINE:</b>	-Tuesday, March 10 <sup>th</sup> , 2015 -Any other will be a day of competition scratch.
<b>OPENING CEREMONIES:</b>	Opening Ceremonies will be 15 minutes prior to competition beginning. Athletes are to be on the approach area in front of their lanes 5 minutes prior to Opening Ceremonies.
<b>HOW TO PROTEST:</b>	-Fill out protest form and submit it to Sports Rules Committee, located at the information booth no later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of the match/game being protested. -The Committee will consist of: Dave Demyan and Terri Jo Podraza, or bowling alley representative. -The Committee will review the protest and make a decision before the start of the next contest, and inform the coach.
<b>COACHES' MEETING:</b>	A coaches' meeting will be held 30 minutes prior to the start of bowling. That will be 8:30 am for the first squad, and 12:30 pm for the second squad.

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<b>WARM-UP PROCEDURES:</b>	There will be a brief stretching and warm up before you begin bowling. You will have 5 minutes prior to the game for practice bowling.
<b>AWARDS:</b>	-All awards will be done on the lanes, at the conclusion of your division on both days. -Results will be emailed to the HODs within 30 days of the conclusion of the contest.
<b>CONCESSIONS:</b>	-Athlete and coach meals will be available for \$2.00. See SONE website for details
