

Special Olympics Nebraska 2020 Spring Sports & Program Internship

DESCRIPTION:

Special Olympics Nebraska (SONE) serves over 7,500 athletes across the state. SONE is seeking an intern to assist and support the program staff for the spring semester. As a Sports & Program Intern, you will assist with the preparation and implementation of SONE events and competitions. Intern will work 5-10 hours per week in the office as well as some nights and weekends for events (20-30 hour weeks).

INTERNSHIP DATES:

January 13th, 2020 – May 24th, 2020 (start date is flexible based on successful applicant's schedule)

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist in development, planning, and execution of Special Olympics regional and state competitions
- Assist with data entry for athlete, volunteer, and coach paperwork
- Assist as needed with other Special Olympics Nebraska projects- this could include learning and using Games
 Management System (computer software used for divisioning athletes in competitions), office/administrative
 tasks, loading and unloading, physical set-up of venues, and customer service
- Other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree in sports management, sports marketing, parks & recreation management or another related field preferred
- Basic computer knowledge of Microsoft Office (Access is a plus)
- Self-motivated, detail-oriented, organized, and focused
- Ability to effectively multi-task
- Ability to work collaboratively as part of a team
- Availability to attend competitions (primarily weekends but sometimes during the week)
- Available to work in the office and at events
- Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds
- Must have a valid driver's license and reliable transportation
- Ability to pass background check
